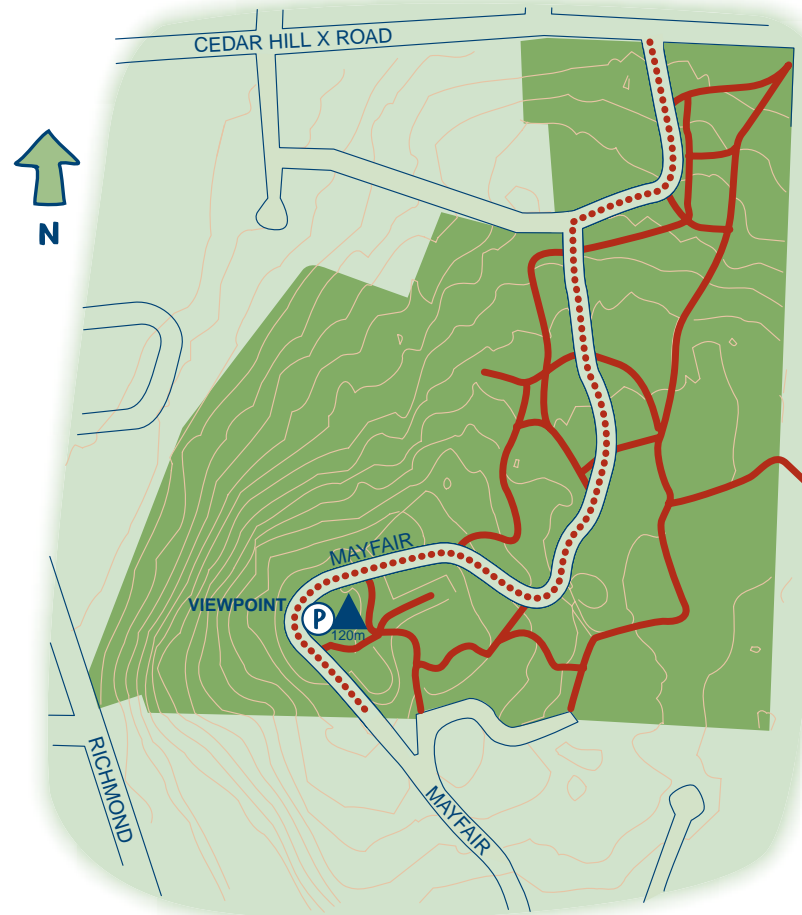


Mount Tolmie Park



Mt. Tolmie was officially named in 1934 after Dr. William Frazer Tolmie, a biologist. Panoramic views of Saanich and Greater Victoria across to the Olympic Mountain Range and to Mt. Baker in the Cascades will entice you to hike to the 120 m elevation of the summit. The combination of structures (such as the water reservoir) and natural pathways through the rocky outcrops provide many different places to explore. Please stay on the trails as many varieties of native wildflowers appear in the spring.
