Adjudicator (Please read carefully)

The adjudicator is the most important step in the processing of a LIFE application without proof of income through a Tax Assessment. The adjudicator should be familiar with the applicant's financial situation as their signature verifies the financial need of the family.

- An adjudicator can be a professional in social work or family services, a school principal or counsellor, a senior recreation administrator, a doctor, a public health nurse, a lawyer or notary public.
- Adjudicators, other than those listed above, may be considered if a written letter from the potential adjudicator outlining the financial need of the family is included with the application.
